The varsity ladies placed an impressive 5 runners in the top 35 to capture 3rd place. Grace Riddle & Rachel Mecca both placed in the top 20 to lead the way with Ava Kontranowski, Avery Shepard, and Maddie Matonican rounding out the point scorers for the Chemics. The Chemic JV runners dominated the reserve race, sweeping the top three positions to earn a first-place team finish. Liv Rohr was the reserve race champion with Sawyer Collins and Cara Bucci close behind in 2nd and 3rd. Senior Laura Brookens set a new personal best time on her way to a seventh-place finish while Sophia Knarr rounded out the point-scorers for Midland.
