- 1 Art, Music, Applied Arts
- World Language or 1 World Language and 1 VPAA or completion of full CTE program.
- 4 General Electives
- 2 TOTAL

Each 9th grade student has a 6-period day. The required subjects fill 4 periods. The remaining 2 periods must be filled. Three combinations are possible.

You may:

- 1. Elect 2 full-year courses, OR
- 2. Elect 1 full-year course & 2 semester courses, OR
- 3. Elect 4 semester courses.

A 7th period is optional. You can add another full-year course or 2 semester choices; however, if you choose seven hours you will be assigned seven hours and that cannot be changed in the future.
