Congratulations to the MHS Boys Swim and Dive team on finishing a strong season at Valleys this past weekend. As a team the boys had over 80% of their swims as either season or lifetime best swims. Some high points of the meet were Dom Heires continuing his hot streak as the fastest freshman 500 swimmer in recent history with a 5:48.31 and Ben Frame with the fastest 500 Free time in the last ten years at MHS with a 5:20.76 and Brenden Granzo with a 4th place finish in the 100 breast. One of the top highlights of the meet was Mitchell McMath finishing in 4th place and breaking a MHS school record set back in 1981 in the 100 Backstroke with a 58.49. And the other top highlight was the 200 Freestyle relay of Jacob Hyde, Lawrence Millward, Mitchell McMath and Trenton Smerdon breaking the school record set back in 2014 in that event and being the first swimmers to make a state cut in the past ten years. Congrats and good luck at States in two weeks.
