Last night MHS girls swim and dive competed in the Saginaw Valley League Championship Meet. Qualifying and advancing to Finals on Saturday are Madison Yocke, Addison Birchmeier, Autumn Brutyn, Jenna Seybert, Maddie Jay, Janelle Harris, Morgan Hussey, Anna Merges, Alyssa Rentsch, Izzy Christiansen, Grace Perz, Avery Miller, Quinn VanZile, and Ana Kickland.

Midland High Varsity Volleyball defeated Bay City Western 3-2 in a 5-set district final thriller at host Bay City Central on Thursday night. The Chemics won set 1, 25-20, lost set 2, 23-25, won set 3, 25-13, lost set 4, 15-25 and worked together as a team to clinch the match win in a decisive game 5, 15-9. Running the offense, Olivia McMath delivered 11 kills, 23 assists, 11 digs while Jenna Rekeweg contributed 18 assists, 6 kills, 7 digs and 4 aces. Nicole Giardina pounded 10 timely kills, while Brooklyn Foster had 7 kills and 2 blocks; Morgan Stewart added 6 kills and 2 blocks; and Brooke Russell had 3 kills and 7 blocks. On defense, Grace Schloop had 27 digs, while Ellie Stevens had 6 crucial digs. The Chemics will return to Bay City Central on Tues. Nov. 8th at 6pm to face Rockford (3-0 winners over Greenville) in the regional semifinal.
