Nicole Giardina added 6 kills and 2 blocks, while Emmalea TerBurgh added 4 kills, and both Brooke Russell and Brooklyn Foster had 3 kills and 1 block each. On defense, Grace Schloop had 10 digs while Ellie Stevens added 7 digs and 3 aces. Emma Buschlen had 5 digs and Brigid O'Malley had 4 digs and 2 aces. Varsity is now 6-5 in the SVL. Midland's next match is at Dow High School on Tuesday Oct. 25th.
